
Guidelines to prepare Project Display Boards for the

Science Research Projects Competition – 2022/23



Project set up & display

Since you want to attract and inform interested spectators and judges, make it easy for them to access your project and the results you have obtained.

a) Display -

Size of the display board is given on the above diagram. Your display should be smaller than the given measurements. Digitally printed banners, A4 papers, Bristol boards could be used to display your project. Your poster should be readable from the distance of 1m. Please adjust the font size of texts appropriately.

b) A good title -

It should be simple and must accurately represent your research. It is recommended to use an attractive title and a scientific, detailed subtitle. Title should fit into 36"×9.5" size box as in the above diagram. Please adjust the font size of the title appropriately.

c) Take photographs -

Projects may involve elements that are not safe to be exhibited at the fair but are an important part of the project. You may take photographs of those important parts/phases of your experiment and use them in your display.

d) Models -

Prepare a miniature of your project in case your prototype is too large to be transported or carried along.

e) Be organized -

Make sure your display is logically presented and easy to read. A glance should enable anyone (particularly the judges) to locate the title, experiments, results and conclusions quickly. When you arrange your display, imagine that you are seeing it for the first time.

f) Eye-catching display –

Make sure your display stands out. Use neat, colorful headings, charts and graphs to present your project. Home-built equipment, construction paper and coloured markers are excellent for project displays. Pay special attention to the labeling of charts, diagrams, graphs and tables. Each item must have a descriptive title.

g) Correctly presented and well-constructed –

Be sure to adhere to the size limitations and safely rules when preparing your display. All forms required for the project should be displayed. Make sure your display is sturdy, as it will need to remain intact for quite a while. Do not hesitate to ask for advice from adults if you need it.
